



**PINAL COUNTY COURTHOUSE  
RENOVATION**  
Florence, Arizona

The courthouse was constructed in 1891 and is a noteworthy example of the American-Victorian style and of nineteenth century construction technology on the Southwestern frontier.

It remains the oldest public building still in use and is one of Arizona's most irreplaceable historic properties.

This multi-phased rehabilitation project features:

Evaluating the building's existing conditions.

Identifying code deficiencies.

Replacing and/or stabilizing the entire roof structure.

Designing lateral load-resisting connections.

Truss stiffeners and bracings.

Restoration of exterior historic finishes.
